

LOCAL RULES

TO BE READ INCONJUNCTION WITH THE RULES OF GOLF AND THE LOCAL RULES BOARD

OUT OF BOUNDS (a) Any line of white stakes (b) The course boundary fences (c) The golf course edge of any formed residents' cart path

ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITION Rule 16 **Immovable Obstruction** (a) concrete gutters with or without timber framework adjacent to concrete cart paths. Relief Rule 16.1.b. (b) All penalty area and GUR stakes. Relief Rule 17.1.d. (c) Sprinkler heads close to putting greens. Rule 16.1b applies. In addition to the types of interference described in Rule 16.1.a, interference also exists if an immovable obstruction is: on the player's line of play, and is within two club-lengths of the putting green, and is within two club-lengths of the ball. (Exception – There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.) **Ground Under Repair In the General Area** (a) All areas defined by blue stakes or white lines on the grass (b) deep ruts caused by vehicle tracks (c) eroded areas in bunkers

DISTANCE INFORMATION

- 100m stone markers on right side of fairways
- 150m stone markers on the left side of fairways

RED PENALTY AREA 11TH AND 17TH HOLES Rule 17.1 and diagram 17.1.d

(a) On the 17th hole south of the bridge and cart path to the 15th green, as an additional option drop a ball in the drop zone with a one stroke penalty (b) On the 11th hole, if the player's ball has failed to cross the green side margin of the red penalty area, the drop zone is the green tee box if the flag is red/white or yellow tee box if the flag is black/white or blue/white. (c) On the 11th hole, if the player's ball has crossed the green side margin of but finished up in the red penalty area, the ball shall be dropped in the drop zone nearest to where the ball crossed the green side margin.

When the player is using the drop zone, the ball must be dropped in the dropping zone and it must come to rest in the dropping zone.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE Unless otherwise noted the penalty for a breach of a local rule is the general penalty. Match Play - loss of hole. Stroke Play - two strokes.

- Sprinkler heads are marked to 250m from the green on par 4s and 5s.
- All measurements are in metres to the centre of the green.
