

TEMPORARY LOCAL RULES

Penalty for breach of a local rule is the *General Penalty*

ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS

(In addition to situations covered under Rule 16 New Rules of Golf 1/01/19)

1. 16.1c Relief for Your Ball in a Bunker

- Areas of erosion and/or storm damage and rock covered walls.
- Free relief under 16.1b except that;
The nearest point of *complete relief* and the *relief area* must be in the bunker.

2. Erosion at Weir on 1st Hole

- The erosion in front of the 1st tee from the weir at the end of the water retention basin is Ground Under Repair (GUR). The area is marked with blue stakes and white lines and is roped off.
Players must not enter this area of GUR to recover a ball.
- If it is known or virtually certain that the ball is in the GUR the player is to proceed under free relief GUR rules.

3. Relief from Embedded Rocks in the General Area

- If a player's ball in the *General Area* has interference* from exposed, embedded rocks (that may damage clubs) the rocks are treated as GUR.
- The player may take full relief under Rule 16.1b.
*Interference does not exist if the embedded rocks only interfere with the player's stance.

4. Relief from Tree Roots in the Fairway

- Any exposed tree roots in the fairway are to be treated as GUR .
- A player may take relief under Rule 16.1b.
